

NOTICE OF IMPLEMENTATION OF DEBTOR IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM

A Debtor Identification Program will be implemented by the Bankruptcy Administrator effective **July 1, 2002**. Beginning with creditors meetings being held on or after that date, **all individual debtors** must provide **picture identification** and **proof of social security number** to the trustee at the meeting of creditors. Failure to do so will result in the creditors meeting being continued and if identification is not then provided, the case may be dismissed.

Only **original** documents will be acceptable (no photocopies). Acceptable forms of *picture identification* include: (1) driver's license, (2) government ID, (3) state picture ID, (4) student ID, (5) U. S. Passport, (6) military ID, and (7) resident alien card. Acceptable forms of *proof of social security number* include: (1) social security card, (2) medical insurance card, (3) pay stub, (4) W-2 form, (5) Internal Revenue Service Form 1099, and (6) Social Security Administration report.

One document can be used for proof of both identification and social security number if it contains both a picture identification and social security number.
