#### **MISCELLANEOUS FEES**

	<b>Fee</b>	<b>Comment</b>
<b>Amendment to Debtors Schedules or Creditor List</b>	\$26.00	Includes an addition or deletion of a creditor; or an Amendment to the amount or classification of the creditor's debt. A change of address does NOT require a fee.

	<b>Fee</b>	<b>Comment</b>
<b>Certification</b>	\$9.00	Fee is charged per document.
<b>Complaint</b>	\$150.00	No fee is charged if the plaintiff is either the debtor or the United States. Also, no fee is charged if the plaintiff is a child support creditor or its representative provided the form required by §304(g) is filed. If the trustee or debtor in possession is the plaintiff, the fee should be payable only from the estate and to the extent there is any estate realized.
<b>Conversion to Chapter 7 Case</b>	\$15.00	Due upon filing of Motion to Convert or upon filing of Notice of Conversion. If the trustee serving in the case is movant, the fee shall be payable only from the estate that exists prior to conversion.
<b>Copy</b>	\$.50	Fee is charged per page.
<b>Cross Appeal</b>	\$255.00	For docketing a cross appeal from a Bankruptcy Court determination.

<b>Deconsolidation</b>	Chapter 7 \$155.00 Chapter 11 \$800.00 Chapter 13 \$155.00 Chapter 12 \$200.00	For dividing a joint case into two separate cases at the request of the debtor(s), a fee shall be charged equal to one half the current filing fee for the chapter under which the joint case was commenced.
<b>Exemplifications</b>	\$18.00	Charged per document
<b>Index of Paper</b>	\$39.00	For filing or indexing any paper not in a case or proceeding for which a filing fee has been paid.
<b>Judgments</b>	\$39.00	Registering a judgment from another District
<b>Motion to Compel Abandonment of Property</b>	\$150.00	No fee is charged if the plaintiff is a child support creditor or its representative provided the form required by §304(g) is filed.
<b>Motion to Terminate, Annul, Modify or Condition the Automatic Stay</b>	\$150.00	Fee is not charged if the motion is filed in conjunction with a properly prepared consent order. Also, no fee is charged if the plaintiff is a child support creditor or its representative provided the form required by

<b>Motion to Withdraw Reference</b>	\$150.00	§304(g) is filed. No fee is charged if the plaintiff is a child support creditor or its representative provided the form required by §304(g) is filed.
<b>Notice of Appeal</b>	\$255.00	Each party filing a notice of appeal must pay the entire fee. Parties jointly filing a notice of appeal only have to pay one fee.
<b>Registry</b>	No Set Fee	A charge of up to 10% of the income earned on the investment shall be assessed by the Clerk for handling registry funds. This fee is to be assessed in accordance with the detailed fee schedule issued by the AO.
<b>Reopening</b>	Chapter 7 \$155.00 Chapter 11 \$800.00 Chapter 13 \$155.00 Chapter 12 \$200.00	Fee is collected at the time of the motion to reopen. Fee is collected in the same amount as the fee required for a new case on the date of reopening, unless the reopening is to correct an administrative error or for actions related to the debtor's discharge. Also, the court may waive the fee "under appropriate circumstances" or may defer the fee for trustees pending discovery of

additional assets.

	<b>Fee</b>	<b>Comment</b>
<b>Reproduction of Recordings</b>	\$26.00	For reproduction of recordings of proceedings, regardless of medium.
<b>Retrieval</b>	\$45.00	For a retrieval of the record from a Federal Records Center or other storage location away from the place of business of the court.
<b>Returned Check</b>	\$45.00	Fee charge for each NSF check.
<b>Search</b>	\$26.00	For every search of the records of the Bankruptcy Court. Fee is charged per name or item searched.
