All interested parties having been given due notice of the hearing, at the hearing, appeared.  The Court finds after hearing on the Motion that the Debtor(s) is/are in default to such that the Motion for relief from stay should be granted; therefore, it is
ORDERED that the Motion for relief from the §362 stay by is granted and the stay lifted as to the Debtor(s)' real property with allowed 180 days from the entry of this Order to file a documented deficiency claim based on liquidation of the real property with the failure of to file a documented deficiency claim based on liquidation of the real property within 180 days from the entry of this Order to result in the lifting of the stay as to the real property being in full satisfaction of the Debtor(s)' liability under the note secured by the real property; and, it is further
ORDERED that any payments scheduled for disbursement by the Trustee on the claim of secured by the real property shall terminate immediately due to relief from stay being granted; and, it is further
ORDERED that any net proceeds remaining after payoff of the indebtedness to the foreclosing lienholder and any junior liens shall be required to be turned over to the Chapter 13

Trustee to be held pending further order of the Court; and, it is further

ORDERED that the fourteen (14) day waiting period imposed by Bankruptcy Rule 4001(a)(3) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure is waived and the automatic stay is immediately terminated.
