

STANDING ORDER

Having concluded that the following new or revised procedures are needed in order to implement the provisions of the United States Code as amended by the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (Pub. L 109-8), it is hereby ORDERED as follows with respect to cases filed on or after October 17, 2005:

(1) A debtor who has completed an instructional course concerning personal financial management of the type described in section 111 after filing the petition, may satisfy the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 1007(b)(7) by filing a certificate from the approved provider that provided the instructional course attesting to the completion of the personal financial management course by the debtor.
