Brian C. Behr has expressed an interest in reappointment for an additional five-year term as the **U.S. Bankruptcy Administrator** for the **Eastern District of North Carolina**.

Mr. Behr's current term is due to expire on May 3, 2027. The Court of Appeals, as appointing authority, has established a review committee to assess this reappointment request.

Bankruptcy administrators are responsible for supervising trustees and debtors-in-possession to ensure that they administer the district's bankruptcy estates effectively.
