## ORDER AMENDING HEARING DATE

On December 10, 2021, this Court entered the Order Under 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a), 363 and 365 of the Bankruptcy Code Approving Bidding Procedures, Break-Up Fee, and Form and Manner of Notice Thereof with Respect to Proposed Sale of Assets by Debtor to Three Blind Mice, LLC. ECF No. 115 ("Bidding Procedures Order"). 1. The Sale Hearing is rescheduled to February 16, 2022 at 9:30 a.m., and all objections to the sale motion shall be filed and served so as to be actually received not later than 5:00 p.m. (EST) on February 14, 2022.

2. All other provisions of the Sale Procedure Order shall remain in effect.

3. Within 24 hours of entry of this Order, Debtor shall serve via U.S. Mail a copy of this Order on the following: (a) all potential purchasers with whom the Debtor has received any communication within the last year concerning an interest in the sale of the Debtor's assets (b) all attorneys and other parties who have entered an appearance in this case; (c) all secured creditors; (d) applicable taxing authorities; (e) the Bankruptcy Administrator; (f) all unsecured creditors. The Debtors shall file a certificate of service with the Court showing that it has complied with this notice procedure.

4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over any matter or dispute arising from or relating to the implementation of this Order or the Sale and Auction Procedures.
