ORDER SETTING 2024 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Federal law establishes public holidays for federal employees, including Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. These holidays are celebrated through closure of the Offices of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of North Carolina.

Thanksgiving Day will be observed on Thursday, November 28, 2024. In extended observance of this holiday, court offices will be closed on Friday, November 29, 2024.

Christmas Day will be observed on Wednesday, December 25, 2024. In extended observance of Christmas Day, court offices will be closed on Tuesday, December 24, 2024. New Year's Day will be observed on Wednesday, January 1, 2025.

Pursuant to Rule 5001 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the bankruptcy court is considered always open for filing motions and any papers. Accordingly, the court's electronic case filing system is available for filing 24 hours per day, 7 days per week for registered users. Parties (including those not registered to use the electronic filing system) anticipating an after-hours emergency must contact the clerk's office during regular office hours to arrange after-hours coverage.
