This Court hereby ORDERS as follows regarding the use of electronic devices in United States Bankruptcy Court facilities in this District:

Radio, television, and internet broadcasting and the use of photographic, electronic, or mechanical reproductions or recording equipment is prohibited in courtrooms or their environs. "Environs" is defined to mean the offices of the judges, the offices of the clerk, or any conference room or corridor connecting or adjacent thereto.

Electronic Device Request and Acknowledgment Forms are available from the clerk's office, and attorneys may request Court permission to bring electronic devices (e.g. cell phone, laptop, tablet, etc.) into courtrooms or their environs by completing and signing the form. The use of electronic devices within the courtrooms or their environs by the requesting attorney is allowed for business purposes only.

This Standing Order supersedes the Standing Order re: Use of Electronic Devices By Attorneys Within Court Facilities entered on January 13, 2013.
