
STANDING ORDER

Having reviewed the Motion filed by the Bankruptcy Administrator for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of North Carolina and the Chapter 13 Trustees for the Winston-Salem, Durham and Greensboro Divisions of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of North Carolina, the Court finds that cause exists to extend the period of time for filing a Final Report and Account and transmitting the same to the Bankruptcy Administrator to 45 days following conversion of a Chapter 13 case to a case under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code and that the filing of the Final Report and Account with the Court shall be considered transmission of the Final Report and Account to the Bankruptcy Administrator. This Order is applicable to all Chapter 13 cases converted to Chapter 7 since October 1, 2012, and shall remain in effect until the Court shall order otherwise.
